Vaccinations

- Weaning-aged Pigs (8 weeks): Parapleuro Shield P & Covexin 8. Booster in 4 weeks.
- Adult Pigs: Parapleuro Shield P & Covexin 8 once yearly
- Sows Prior to Farrowing: Parapleuro Shield P & Covexin 8

***There are other risk based vaccines (ie. Rabies vaccine) that the veterinarians may recommend based on your individual pig's risk level.

Deworming

- Deworm twice yearly
 - o Alternate between Ivomec injectable and Panacur oral suspension
 - Outdoor Pigs: Ideally given in Spring & Fall
 - Indoor Pigs: Time of year is irrelevant
- Fecal exams are recommended twice yearly to determine efficacy of protocol and adjust treatment according to results.
- Sows Prior to Farrowing: Deworm with Ivomec injectable

Other
